

Cato Bailey
c.1830-1901
Civil War

Cato Bailey served in the Thirty-third US Colored Troops of the US Army during the Civil War. Born in Saint Augustine, Florida, Bailey was a slave before escaping slavery prior to his military service. Afterwards, he worked as a laborer, including a drayman in Saint Augustine. He died in 1901 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
