Thomas Hanandos served as a Private in the US Army in the Civil War. Born in Saint Augustine, Florida, he ran away to Beaufort, South Carolina, prior to his military service. Afterwards, he returned to Saint Augustine where he died in 1915. Hanandos is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.

 was born in St Augustine Fla, was enlisted the 12 day of
 January, 1863, at Camp Barton S.C., by William James,
 and was mustered in the 31st day of January, 1863,
 at Beaufort S.C., by Pny. Genl. R. Saxton, for 3 years.
 At the time of enlistment he was 30 years old, and 5 feet
 2 inches high, Light complexion, Blue eyes, Black hair,
 and by occupation a Laborer. He was discharged (served) 31st day
 of January, 1864, at Charleston S.C.
 Capt William James was commanding officer, and Robert
 Bolin first sergeant at time of soldier's discharge. The following are
 the names of one or more of his company who enlisted at or about the same time and place:
 Thomas Hanandos enlisted 12 day of January
 1863, and Martin Natel enlisted 12 day of
 January, 1863.
