Thomas Hanandos (c. 1842-1915) Civil War

Thomas Hanandos served as a Private in the US Army in the Civil War. Born in Saint Augustine, Florida, he ran away to Beaufort, South Carolina, prior to his military service.

Afterwards, he returned to Saint Augustine where he died in 1915. Hanandos is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.










"Thomas Hanandos." Interment Card for Thomas Hernandez.
