Colored Troops of the US Army in the Civil War. Born in Saint
Augustine, Florida, he ran away from slavery to Beaufort, South
Carolina, prior to his military service. Afterwards, he returned
to Saint Augustine where he died before or during the year
1890. Hewlin is buried in the Saint Augustine National
Cemetery.










"William Hewlin." Civil War Service Card.








"William Hewlin." 1874 Freedman's Bureau Record. Hewlin applied on February 3, 1874.








"William Hewlin." Headstone. St. Augustine National Cemetery.
