
Myer (?Miles) Jackson (?-1931) Civil War

Myer Jackson served as a Private in the Twenty-First US Colored Infantry during the Civil War. His pre-war life is unknown. After the war, he returned to Saint Augustine where he died in 1931. Jackson is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.




