
Nathaniel Jackson (?-1896) Civil War

Nathaniel Jackson served as a Private and Corporal in the Thirty-third United States Colored Infantry during the Civil War. His pre-war life is unknown. After the war, he returned to Saint Augustine where he died in 1896. Jackson is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.



"Nathaniel Jackson." Pension Record. Jackson started receiving an Army pension on October 2, 1879.








"Nathaniel Jackson." 1880 United States Federal Census.




"Nathaniel Jackson." Headstone.
