
Jacob McKeaver (c.1841-1890) Civil War

Jacob McKeaver served in the Thirty-fourth Regiment, US Colored Troops of the US Army in the Civil War. Born in Georgia, he likely was a runaway slave prior to his military service. Afterwards, he worked as a laborer in Saint Augustine, Florida. McKeaver died in 1890 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.









"Jacob McKeaver." 1880 United States Census. McKeaver (line 20) listed as a laborer in Saint Augustine, FL.





"Jacob McKeaver." U.S. Burial Registers. Death of McKeaver on March 31, 1890. Listed as both McKeaver and McQuaver.






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"Jacob McKeaver." Cemetery Interment Control Forms. Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
