## James Nelson c. 1874-1898 Spanish-American War

James Nelson served in the Twenty-fourth Infantry of the US Army during the Spanish-American War. Born in Maryland, he worked as a laborer prior to his military service. Nelson died of typhoid fever in Tampa, Florida, during his service and was originally buried in Ybor City. Nelson is currently buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.






