Spanish-American War

Charles Parks served in the Tenth Cavalry of the US Army during the Spanish-American War. Born in Kentucky, Parks worked as a laborer prior to his military service. Parks died during the war in 1898 and was originally buried in Lakeland, Florida. He is now buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
