Civil War

John Robinson served as a Corporal in Company F of the Thirty-fourth United States Colored Infantry during the Civil War. His pre-war life is unknown. After the war, he settled in Saint Augustine, working as a laborer, with his wife and children until his death. Robinson died in 1890 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
