
Jacob Stewart (?)-1925 Civil War

Jacob Stewart served as a Private in the Company E, Thirty-fourth United States Colored Infantry during the Civil War. His pre-war life is unknown. Afterwards, he returned to Saint Augustine and lived there with his family. Stewart died in 1925 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.








"Jacob Stewart." Civil War Service Card.




"Jacob Stewart." Freedmen's Bureau Record.

Stewart applied at the Freedmen's Bureau on May 10, 1866.








"Jacob Stewart." 1900 United States Census.

Occupation listed as Daily Laborer.








"Jacob Stewart." 1910 United States Census.


