**Philippine-American War**

Charles E.T. Wade served as a private in the Company K, Ninth U.S. Cavalry during the Philippine-American War. Born in the West Indies and immigrating to Maryland, he worked as a laborer prior to his service. Wade remained in the Philippine Islands after the war and started a family before travelling to Jacksonville, Florida, where he died in 1938. Today he rests in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery in Saint Augustine, Florida.
