William Walden 1866-1898 Spanish-American War

William H. Walden served in the Spanish-American War in the Tenth US Cavalry as a blacksmith. Born in Vigo County, Indiana, he married Mary E. Cook prior to enlistment. Serving for six years, he died in Lakeland, Florida, where his unit trained for deployment overseas from an acute peritonitis in 1898.


"William Walden." 1870 United States Census.

Walden lived with his parents Marshall and Caroline and his five other siblings in Virgo, IN.








"William Walden." 1892 Register of Enlistments.

Walden (line 15) enlisted in the US Army on Nov. 1, 1892 at 26 in Terre Haute, IN to the Company K Tenth Cavalry.








"William Walden." 1896 Register of Enlistments.

Ft. Leavenworth, KS, Company K Tenth Cavalry.








"William Walden." Buffalo Soldiers Morning Report.

Walden (right, line 25) died on July 1, 1898 from acute peritonitis caused by an incision wound across the chest and abdomen.








"William Walden." Cemetery Burial Records.


