
"Mrs Alfred W. Adams has just received an interesting letter from her sister. Miss Agnes D. Marcus, who is a Red Cross nurse doing service in a camp hospital in France. Miss Marcus writes that she met her brother, Lieut. Carlton P. Marcus, on his way from the front, and that they traveled as far as Paris together. Lieut. Marcus was in the St. Mihiel drive and also the battle of Argonne Forest, but escaped without injury, and is now in Southern France. They both hope to be home very shortly."





"Miss Agnes D. Marcus, 83, resident of a local nursing home, passed away Thursday, March 18, 1971. Born in Woodbury, N.J., Miss Marcus came here in 1945 from Pleasantville, N.J. She was a retired civil service employee. Miss Marcus was a member of the First Methodist Church, St. Petersburg. During World War I Miss Marcus was in the Army Nursing Corps.
