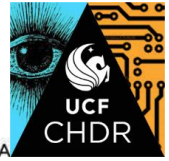

“Forty nurses were graduated from the training school of the Boston City Hospital at exercises held yesterday afternoon in the out-patient department. Edward J. Slattery, representing Mayor Curley, spoke briefly, and Dr. David D. Scannell sought to impress upon the young women the responsibilities of their calling.
