



The Waacs are Auxiliaries Catherine Obrien, Anna C. Pastuck, Geraldine M. Phelps, Leona K. Perry, Lucy A. Pietrogallo, Eleanor M. Podeszwa, Lydia A. Rankin, Anna Rinkovsky, Manila G. Rupert and Lillie Wilbanks."

Article Transcription:

"Gulfport Field, Miss., Dec. 3. – Pvt. Leona K. Perry of Poultney, Vt., is among the rapidly expanding group of skilled Air-WACS playing a prominent role in daily operations at this large airplane mechanics school and basic training center of the Army Air Forces Eastern Technical Training command.

Among one of the first groups of Air-WACS, as they are better known in the air corps, to "take over" here during the summer, she has been on duty with the station hospital detachment, one of the many units in which members of the Women's Army corps have assumed essential work formerly carried out by soldiers.


Enlisting at Rutland last March, Pvt. Perry underwent basic training at Daytona Beach, Fla., later attending the Army cooks and bakers school at that station. And while experiencing Army life to the fullest extent, she has much in common for the present and post-war period with her brothers, Pvt. Joseph Perry, attached to a Field Artillery unit in Colorado, and Pvt. Leo McNamara with the Army Air corps at Miami Beach, Fla. The Gulfport Air-WAC is a graduate of Poultney High school."







"Daytona Beach, Fla. – Leona K. Snow, 89, went home to be with the Lord April 1, 2011.

She grew up in Poultney, Vt., and moved to Daytona Beach, Fla., in 1998.

She was a member of the Women's Army Corps during WWII. Her basic training was in Daytona Beach. From there, she was stationed in Gulf Port (Miss.) Army Hospital as a dietician.

Leona worked at Rutland (Vt.) Regional Medical Center as a nurse's aide for 18 years. She loved to cook, paint pictures, do crosswords and read her Bible.

She was a faithful member of Crossroads Baptist Church and attended Young at Heart, Anita Smith's Bible Study and Saints Alive.

Surviving are her two daughters. Linda Snow of Daytona Beach and Patricia (Rick) Stanton of Ormond Beach; her son, John (Mary) of Tinmouth, Vt.; four grandchildren, Leann Snow, Shane (Allison) Stanton, Marianne (Stephane) Goulet and Mike (Becky) Snow; six great-grandsons, Gavin and Evin Stanton, Nicolas and Gabriel Goulet and Anakin and Ronan Snow; her sister, Evelyn Huntington of Corinth, Vt.; several nieces and nephews..."


