

"Friends of Mark J. Jones, of Slatington, will be interested to know that he has enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps and is stationed at navy yard at Charleston, S.C. While employed in Philadelphia last year at the time of the President's call he enlisted in a Philadelphia company and saw service on the Mexican border. In a letter he says he liked the service so well that he decided to enlist."

Transcription:

(Mark Jones sent a letter to his friend William Caskie. The letter is as follows:)

"Dear 'Buster':-

A few lines to let you know that I am enjoying perfect health and enjoy my Naval Training here at Port Royal very much.

This is my last of drilling, and school of a squad and school of a soldier. Next Monday we go to the rifle range to qualify, remaining there about two and one-half weeks, at the end of which time we will leave this training station for different parts of the world.

'Buster,' old friend, I want you to have this entire letter published in the 'Allentown Morning Call,' for it might be the means of getting some fellows to volunteer their services for Uncle Sam, I presume you know that Uncle Sam has 50,000,000 nephews who would make splendid marines, soldiers or sailors.

I am making the following to all boys who love their Country, 'Old Glory,' their homes, mothers, sweethearts and wives:

The crisis is very near, our beloved country is in danger. Our fighting forces are asking for your assistance. We sincerely hope you will hearken to their appeal. We know it is hard to realize that our dear country is at war, but we must wake up to the fact and do our duty by it to the best of our ability. Surely you would not like to see your country humiliated and defeated, and officers and color bearers have to surrender their swords and colors to the enemy. Never! Never! All honor to her, our Country, and to our dear beloved President. Hurry on, boys; hurry on!"

(He includes the Marines' Hymn then finishes the letter.)

"Well 'Buster' as 'call to quarters' has just sounded (9:45 p. m.) and I only have fifteen minutes until Taps (10:00 p. m.) to make up my bunk for the night, and all lights are turned out at taps, I must get on the jump. Trusting you are enjoying perfect health, with remembrance to the rest of the family; send me a copy of 'The Call' that this letter is published in, and hoping to hear from you real soon, I remain your old friend, MARK J. JONES."





Transcription:

"Mark J. Jones, son of Joseph Jones of Stalington, is home on a short furlough from General Hospital No. 31, Carlisle Pa. Jones is wearing the service stripes of two armies, the English and the American.

He enlisted in the English army at Halifax, Nova Scotia, on December 11, 1916, as a sapper in the Royal Engineers. He arrived in France the following February and went into action at Royes, France, where he was wounded by shrapnel and gassed on the first day of action, March 21. After convalescing in hospitals in France and England he returned to the front for more of it. On July 22, 1918, he was discharged from the British army and one week later enlisted in the American army attached to the Staff, Base Section No. 3, Service of Supplies, as a stenographer, his wounds having rendered him unfit for active duty on the front. He was later made a courier between Paris, Tours, and London. He left Brest, France, on January 24, 1919, aboard the B. C. V. Adriatic, docking at New York harbor in February.

Jones was employed at the Bethlehem Steel Works prior to his enlistment, as an accountant in the Traffic Department."

Transcription:

"Mark Joseph Jones, World War veteran who served in the Army, Navy and Marine Corps and was several times wounded, died last night at 7 o'clock at the Naval hospital as a result of wounds received in France. He was 35 years of age and resided at 308 North Spring street.


The deceased was in France when the conflict began in Europe in 1914 and served with a detachment of Americans in both the French and English armies before enlisting in the U.S. Army when this country declared war. He underwent 19 major operations as the result of wounds he received in various battles and had received treatment in almost every service hospital in the United States.

Upon the advice of physicians at New York City, where he was in an Army hospital, Mr. Jones was transferred to the Navy because it was believed that he might recover if assigned to sea duty. He was on a naval ship that came to Pensacola five years ago, and suffering a breakdown, he was assigned to duty here and later discharged.

He married Miss Anita Seely of Pensacola, who with their little daughter survive him. Mr. Jones also has a number of relatives in his native state of Pennsylvania.

The deceased was a member of the Knights of Columbus and the American Legion and was organizer of the local chapter of Disabled American Veterans.

T. M. Lloyd Company has charge of funeral arrangements, announcement of which will be made later."






