Albert Bass served in the 536<sup>th</sup> Engineer Service Battalion of the US Army during World War I. Born in Gordon, Alabama, Bass worked as a farmer prior to his military service. Afterwards, he continued to farm in Houston County, Alabama. Bass died in 1940 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
