## Robert Brooks 1895-1944 World War I

Robert Brooks served in the 151<sup>st</sup> Depot Brigade of the US Army during World War I. Born in Granden, Florida, Brooks worked as a bellman in Saint Augustine, Florida prior to his military service. Afterwards, he worked as a tailor in Saint Augustine. Brooks died in 1944 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.








