World War I

Stanley Copeland served in the 802nd Pioneer Infantry of the US Army during World War I. Born in Jacksonville, Florida, Copeland worked as a laborer prior to his military service. Afterwards, he worked as a driver in Tampa, Florida. Copeland died in 1934 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.

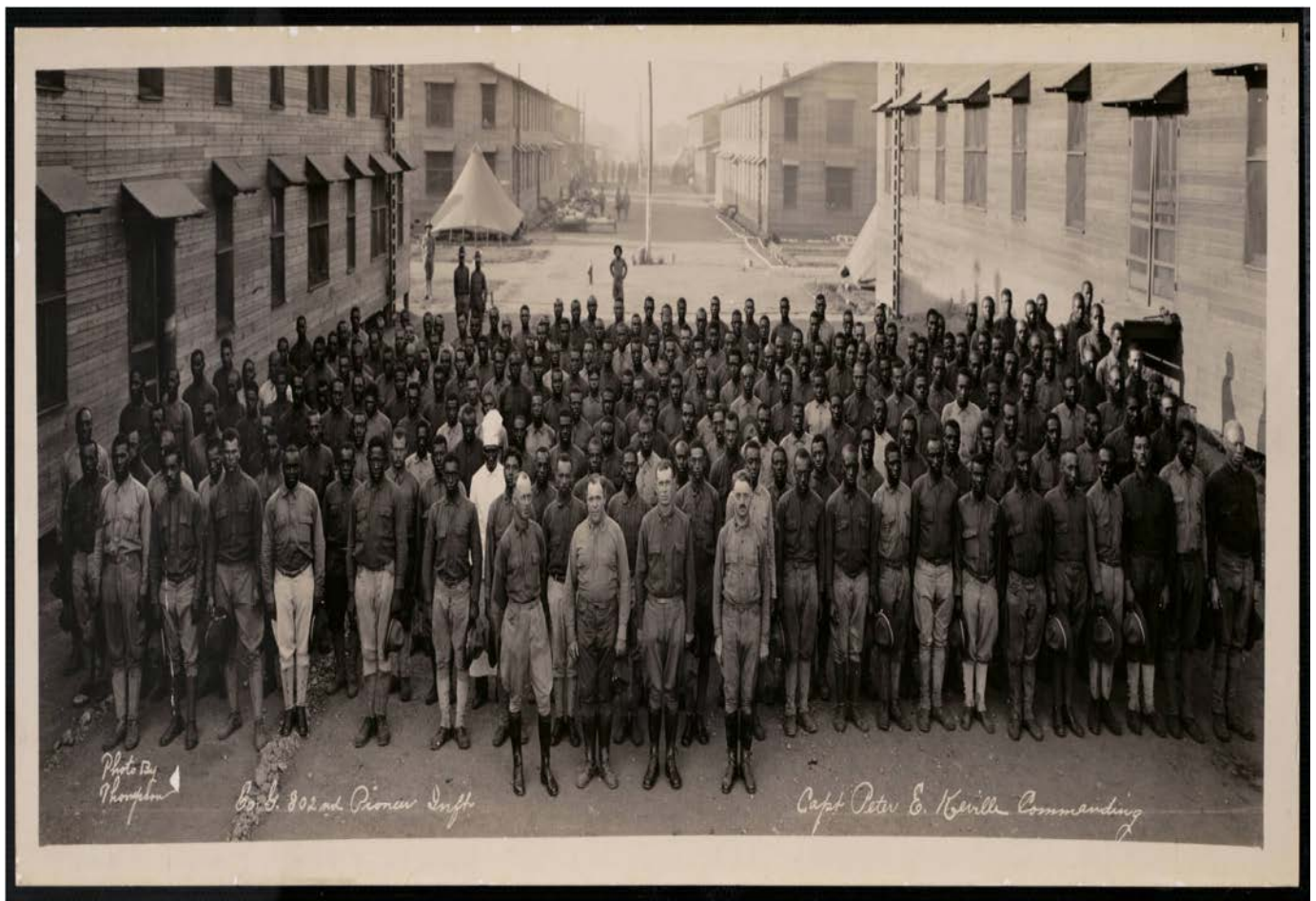

TROOPSHIP NANSEMOND BRINGS 5,252 HAPPY MEN

Colored Pioneer Infantry Troops
Glad to Be Away From Road
Work in France.

The transport Nansemond, - from Brest, with 5,252 members of the A. E. F. on board, docked at Pier No. 1, Hoboken, to-day. She left Brest on June 28.

One unit on the Nansemond, deliriously glad to get home, was the 802d Pioneer Infantry, composed of 1,969 Southern negroes. They were in command of 53 white officers.

The 802d went to France last August and was attached to the First Army. After the armistice the regiment was put on salvage work and road reconstruction and as one of them said to-day "It suttinly was WORK."

This regiment produced the Verdun Minstrels, a noted entertainment company, and the 802d Pioneer Infantry Band. Both were organized by an energetic Ethiopian named "Rockpile" Johnson.

The transport Santa Olivia, from Bordeaux, docked at Bush Terminal with 1,757 casuals. Bordeaux was closed as a port of debarkation when the Santa Olivia left there. This was the Santa Olivia's last trip as a transport. Through the Shipping Board she will be turned back to her owner, W. B. Grace & Co.
