### **World War I**

Charles Crummer served in the 367<sup>th</sup> Infantry of the Ninety-second Division during World War I. Born in Palatka, Florida, Crummer worked as a laborer prior to his military service. Crummer died in 1934 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
