### **World War I**

Gus Franklin served in the 305<sup>th</sup> Labor Service Battalion of the US Army during World War I. Franklin was born and raised in Lawtey, Florida. Franklin died in 1942 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.

3rd Class: All enlisted men below Color Sergeant (A. R. Par. 9), arranged according to usual formation of Company, that is, BY SQUADS.

This form when used to list CASUAL military passengers will be accomplished in like manner, but within each class all names will be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1. The word "Casual" and the name of the organization will be entered in the space provided for name of organization, and the Embarkation Personnel Adjutant will sign his name in the space provided for the signature of organization commander.
