Henry Jones served as a Private in the Company D, 367th Infantry of the Ninety-second Division, Company K, Stevedore and Labor Battalion, Company A, 336th Labor Battalion, and the 815th Transportation Corps during World War I. Born in Augusta, Georgia, he lived in New York, New York, prior to his military service. His post-war life is unknown. Jones died in 1942 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.



Served overseas between June 5, 1918 and May 20, 1919.








"Henry Jones." WWI Army Passenger Lists.




"Henry Jones." WWI Army Passenger Lists.


