### **World War I**

Robert Jones served in the Field Remount Squadron at Camp Johnston as part of the US Army during World War I. Born in Alachua, Florida, Jones worked as a laborer prior to his military service. Jones died in 1946 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
