Logan died in 1943 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.








"Houston Logan." List of Men Order to Report. Logan listed among men from Jefferson County, AL.









Logan lists his mother Jamie Colvin as his emergency contact.








"Houston Logan." Army Transport List.

"Houston Logan." *USS Aquitania*. Logan and his unit sailed back from Brest, France to the US.




