Robert McNeal served with 424th Reserve Labor Battalion of the US Army during World War I. Born in Clinton, Alabama, McNeal worked as a fireman in Tampa, Florida prior to his military service. McNeal died in 1939 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
