Leroy Preston 1884-1949 World War I

Leroy Preston served in the 519th Engineer Service and later the Fifteenth Engineer Service Battalions of the US Army during World War I. Born in Saint Augustine, Florida, he worked as a tailor prior to his military service. Afterwards, he worked as a porter in a hotel in Saint Augustine. Preston died in 1949 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.










"Leroy Preston." USS Northern Pacific.







Preston aboard the *USS Santa Elisa* from Bordeaux, France to Brooklyn, NY. Listed his wife Helen Preston as emergency contact.






"Leroy Preston." 1920 United States Census Preston (line 97) and his wife Helen in Saint Augustine, FL. Preston worked as a porter at a hotel.




