
Charlie Thomas (1896-1947) World War I

Charlie Thomas served as a Private in the 157th Depot Brigade and as a Private First Class in Company A, 317th Labor Battalion during World War I. He lived in Valdosta, Georgia, working as a porter prior to his military service. Afterwards, he returned to Valdosta. Thomas died in 1947 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.




Thomas was inducted on June 19, 1918 in Valdosta, Georgia.
