
Arthur Tomlinson (c1891-1926) World War I

Arthur Tomlinson served as a Private in the Headquarters, 350th Field Artillery Regiment, Ninety-second Infantry Division, in World War I. He lived in Saint Augustine, Florida, with his family prior to his military service. Afterwards, he returned to Saint Augustine and worked as a laborer. Tomlinson died in 1926 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.








"Arthur Tomlinson." 1900 US Federal Census. Tomlinson with his father, mother, and four siblings.






"Arthur Tomlinson." 1910 US Federal Census






"Arthur Tomlinson." List of Men Ordered to Report.

Tomlinson Sent to Report at Tuskegee, Alabama.








"Arthur Tomlinson." WWI Army Passenger Lists.




"Arthur Tomlinson." Headstone.
