Jason Waitman served in the 547th Engineer Service Battalion of the US Army during World War I. Born in Lake City, Florida, Waitman worked a driver in Saint Augustine, Florida prior to his military service. Waitman died in 1936 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
