World War I

Crozier Williams served in the 807th Pioneer Infantry of the US Army during World War I. Born in Waynesboro, Georgia, Williams worked as laborer in Sebring, Florida prior to his military service. Afterwards, he worked as a brakeman in Waycross, Georgia. Williams died in 1948 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
