### **World War I**

Joseph Williams served in the 807<sup>th</sup> Pioneer Infantry of the US Army during World War I. Born in Saint Augustine, Florida, Williams worked as a cook prior to his military service. Afterwards, he worked as a laborer in Saint Augustine. Williams died in 1942 and is buried in the Saint Augustine National Cemetery.
